



WE'VE CREATED THIS MEASURING GUIDE TO HELP YOU CALCULATE THE LENGTH AND WIDTH OF YOUR GARDEN SO THAT YOU KNOW HOW MUCH GRASS YOU WILL NEED!

- 1) Measure your garden's dimensions.
- 2) Use each square of the grid as one square meter (m²).
- 3) Draw your garden from the primary vantage point – this is usually the view from your house.
- 4) Count the squares to give a rough guide on the size of your lawn. If you have curved areas, allow a little extra length for a small amount of wastage.

THINGS TO CONSIDER

- All rolls should be laid in the same direction to give the best finish
- Our artificial grass comes in 2m or 4m widths, and lengths up to 25m
- The grass should be laid so that you have as few joints between rolls as possible – any necessary joints should be placed in inconspicuous areas. Grass should be rolled out length by length away from your house.
